

## TRAIL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

- The Heritage Trail is for anyone who is interested in learning more about Hawaii's heritage.
- You are representing the BSA in public, so wear your proper uniform.
- The trail must be hiked. (Physically challenged scouts need not hike)
- Pay close attention to the hours of operation and the written regulations of historic landmarks.
- Scouting units **MUST** turn in a tour permit prior to the hike (turn in permit 7 days prior to hike).
- At least two adults must accompany any group. At least one BSA registered adult must accompany any scout group.
- Follow all BSA safe hiking rules.
- Cross streets only at designated crosswalks.
- Please do not litter the trail or deface any property. Remember the Outdoor Code.
- Each participant must fill out his/her own questionnaire.
- When admission fees are collected you are not required to enter the facility, but they are highly recommended. Keep in mind that spending time at any facility will increase the time it takes to complete the Heritage Trail.
- We hope you enjoy the trail and become more fully aware and appreciate these historic areas of our city.
- Did you know there is a second BSA Heritage trail located in Honolulu, Hawaii?
- The Leader's Info Sheet contains route directions, locations of answers to the questionnaire, hours of operations, and locations of available restrooms and water fountains.

- The Hilo Heritage Trail is written using Mooheau Park as the starting and end point due to the availability of public parking and restrooms. Other starting points with such facilities include Liliuokalani Park, Wailoa State Park, or the bayfront soccer fields.
- **Hilo Heritage Trail Length: 6.5 Miles**
- **Time to Complete Hilo Heritage Trail: 4 1/2 Hours**
