

## HOW TO GUIDE FOR TAKING YOUTH PROTECTION TRAINING

(Recommended Browsers are Google Chrome for the PC or Safari for the MAC).

- 1. Go to http://my.scouting.org
- 2. Enter your login name and password.
- 3. On the opening page of my.scouting.org, click on the Youth Protection logo for English or Spanish.



4. On the Youth Protection Training page of the BSA Learn Center, select VISIT or RETAKE under your selected language for the Mandatory - Youth Protection Training.



5. The Youth Protection Training consists of three modules and a test module. <u>All three modules will need to be completed</u> <u>before taking the test module.</u> Select START or RETAKE for each module to being the training.
